A RESOLUTION CANVASSING THE RETURNS OF THE GENERAL ELECTION HELD ON THE 3rd DAY OF MAY 2025, TO ELECT COUNCIL MEMBERS FOR MAYOR, POSITIONS 1, AND POSITION 2, EACH FOR A TWO-YEAR TERM; AND DECLARING THE RESULTS OF SAID ELECTION.

WHEREAS, on the 6th day of February 2025, the Council of the City of Brookshire ordered the General Election to be held on May 3, 2025, for the purpose of electing Mayor, and Council members for City Council Place one (1), and two (2); and

WHEREAS, on May 4, 2024, an election was held to elect Mayor and councilmembers to fill Places I and 2; and
