Hello everyone, please see the updates from the conversation Vickie and I had with Lasker and Son's this afternoon. Due to the tight turnaround time, please let me know if you have any objections or suggestions to these changes:

#### Museum Area And City Hall Beds:

Red Yucca swapped for Flax Lily Russian Sage swapped for Drift Rose, White

\*There is a weed issue in these beds because if we replant them now, the weeds will be back when the county event happens in April. We talked about getting a work order approved ASAP first to chemically treat the nut grass infestation in the bed, which takes a few weeks to take effect. A few days before the event on the 22nd of April, the beds will be "fake" planted with blooming drift roses in their containers and fresh mulch. This is only a temporary solution to make sure the beds look fresh and clean for the event's debut. Lasker's does not recommend a complete permanent replant of these two beds until the nutgrass has been eliminated. Once it has been fully treated. we can proceed with a permanent installation.

#### Ornamental Trees For Museum:

(These are focal trees which will make an impact at the museum so we need to be sure we are OK with any of these being the focal point for the Museum entrance)

Desert Willow (Lasker's Proposal)
Texas Mountain Laurel (My recommendation)
Red Crape Myrtle (Vickie's Favorite, also really pretty)
Please let us know your preference

#### **Hwy 90 Plantings**

Recommendation is putting a knockout rose on each side of the crape myrtle beds and a row of grasses in the back. Lasker's recommends Daylilies, my recommendation is Flax Lily.

Amanda, please let me know if you have any suggestions.

#### Fountain Area In The Back

Lasker's made a new recommendation, which is to essentially make the entire bed decomposed granite covering instead of mulch. It is a cleaner look and requires less maintenance. Let me know what you think, I am actually ok with the original estimate on here. Lasker's expects the pricing to be similar in cost.
