



Notice of Regular City Council Meeting

The City Council for the City of Brookshire, Texas, will hold its regular city council meeting on December 21, 2023, at 7:00 p.m. at Brookshire City Hall, 4029 5th Street, for the purpose of considering the following:

Engaging in verbal attacks or comments intended to insult, abuse, malign or slander any individual shall be cause for termination of speaking privileges and expulsion from Council Chambers. Your comments are limited to three (3) minutes.)*
6. Consent Agenda *Items listed under the Consent Agenda are considered routine and are generally enacted in one motion. The exception to this rule occurs when a Council Member requests one or more items removed from the Consent Agenda for separate discussion and action.*

- b. Discuss and consider City of Brookshire MLK Day Unity Brunch budget and agenda.
- c. Discuss and consider awarding a contract for the purchase of mobile data, computer aided dispatch, records management systems and technical support for the Police Department to be paid by American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds and to grant the Mayor or City Administrator the authority to sign any and all documents related to the Project.
- d. Discuss and consider awarding the purchase of (6) dual antenna radar systems for the Police Department to be paid by American Rescue Plan Act (ARPA) funds and to grant the Mayor or City Administrator the authority to sign any and all documents related to the Project.
